What Do You Love About Your Library?

Whether you visit your library building, or use technology to bring the library to you, we appreciate how you creatively use your membership.

Library members made impressive use their digital library in 2020. Members downloaded over 61,000 songs from the library's Freegalapp in 2020. That was an increase of 14% over 2019.

Members also downloaded nearly 127,000 eBook and audiobooks on the Overdrive app, which was 20% more than 2019. Meanwhile, inside the brick-and-mortar locations, librarians developed a curbside service system, revamped reading spaces and some have reconfigured book stacks.
